SORTING OUT DISAGREEMENTS


- Cool down
- Keep problems small
- Be willing to fix the problem
- Ask a teacher to help sort it out
- Talk honestly
- Use I statements
- Say what the problem is for you
- Don't 'put down' or threaten
- Listen to what the problem is for them
- Don't interrupt
- Think of ways to make things better
- Let go of the hurt and move on
- Don't pass on bad stories or gossip

Students' Information




At this school we respect people and property.

- Walk bikes, scooters and skateboards in the school yard.


WE LOOK AFTER OUR SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT AND ALL PROPERTY
